

Minutes
Berrysburg Borough Council
April 9, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Marlin Troutman, Crystal Scheib, Jody Boyer, Timothy Weaver, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice President - Scott Harner, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Robin Snyder gave a COG report which included surface coating on roads and the proposed audit of Upper Dauphin Tax Office.

Scott Harner made a motion to accept the insurance renewal and set up quarterly payments, second by Jody Boyer, all in favor.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to accept the proposal from Wood Wise Tree Service to remove ten trees and tree trimming for \$3,900.00, second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to cite Jonathan Campbell for failure to obtain a building permit for his greenhouse, second by Jody Boyer, all in favor.

A motion was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Marlin Troutman to pay the borough bills, all in favor.
