

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**August 13, 2012**

**Old Business:**

Joseph Shaffer gave a report on his property; he has two items to complete (chimney and drain pipe at back of the property).

Jonathan Campbell discussed his storm water management plan and will have the borough engineer look at the plan.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to purchase materials to repair drain boxes on North First & Main Street, and South Second & School Street, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to purchase a drain box for South First & Lykens Street, second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

**New Business:**

An insurance dividend check was received for the 2011-12 policy year in the amount of \$1,394.37.

Scott Harner spoke to Dale Hoover, who has historical records that he would donate to the borough if a historical society was developed.

The sewer plant will need to be updated with an approximate cost of \$700,000.

Scott Harner reported that the fire company will try to apply for monies from the gaming funds to purchase a new brush truck.

A motion was made by Jody Boyer, second by Marlin Troutman to pay the borough bills, all in favor.
