December 8, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Jody Boyer, Lahn Kopp, Deb Libby, Crystal Scheib, Marlin Troutman, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice-President - Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Correspondence received was read including a request for a voluntary donation to Upper Paxton Township for the recycling program. Timothy Weaver made a motion to donate \$14.47 to Upper Paxton Township for the recycling program as requested, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

Mifflin Township advised the borough that they donate \$5,000 annually to the fire company.
