

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**February 9, 2015**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Jody Boyer, Lahn Kopp, Deb Libby, Crystal Scheib, Marlin Troutman, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice-President - Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Minutes for the January meeting were approved with a motion by Deb Libby, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

Treasurer Report for January was approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Public Comments – none.

**Old Business:**

Local audit was completed on February 7, 2015 for 2014.

Robin Snyder reported that the Woodman of the World pay rent for their meetings held at the Community Center.

Deb Libby reported that there was no soap in the ladies room at the Community Center when the spaghetti supper was held on February 7, 2015 and also the snow was plowed into a few parking spaces resulting in limited parking for that Community Center event. Deb also reported that there will be a pot pie event at the Community Center the end of March.

The insurance renewal was discussed and the amount of insurance at the storage building. It was decided that the insurance agent would be questioned as to savings on that building if insurance was reduced from \$40,000 to \$10,000. This item will be on the agenda for the March meeting.

Boys scouts using the Community Center was discussed and Deb Libby will take the idea of the boy scouts helping with fund raisers in exchange for using the Community Center to the Community Center Committee.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to renew the web page with Network Solutions for one year at the cost of \$158.49, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

Municipal gun ordinances were discussed as a lot of municipalities are repealing their laws due to organizations challenging those laws. The borough has an ordinance prohibiting discharging a weapon within the borough.

A motion to pay borough bills was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Crystal Scheib, all in favor except for Jody Boyer who abstained.

A motion to adjourn was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Jody Boyer, all in favor.
