

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**January 14, 2013**

**Old Business:**

Jonathan Campbell's storm water management plan for his new business was discussed. Ted August should have the final plan for the February 11<sup>th</sup> meeting. Jody Boyer made a motion to accept the storm water management plan for one building contingent that construction can continue in order to open the business by the middle of February, second by Marlin Troutman, with a plan finalized by the February meeting to

submit to the borough engineer for his review, all in favor.
