

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**January 4, 2016**

Meeting was called to order following the re-organization meeting with the following members present – Crystal Scheib, Deb Libby, Lahn Kopp, Jonathan Campbell, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice President – Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Minutes for the December meeting were approved with a motion by Lahn Kopp, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Public Comments – None.

Mayor's report – Koppenhaver Builder is demolishing a structure located at S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for Valerie Dowling. Mud is on the streets where Abner Riehl and Mike Bettis are working on projects in the borough.

**Old Business:**

Jonathan Campbell gave an update on his storm water management plan.

Mike Bettis storm water management plan update – waiting for signed application and payment of fees. Cole Boyer, borough engineer, will contact Mike Bettis' engineer in regards to recording at the Dauphin County Courthouse.

Abner Riehl storm water management plan update - discussed a letter from Cole Boyer dated December 30, 2015 and his comments. Cole Boyer recommended to table the plan for one month so his comments can be addressed. Michael Ward will contact Abner Riehl requesting a letter from him granting an extension of time until March 14, 2016 to allow the comments in Cole's letter to be addressed. Timothy Weaver made a motion for the extension and if Abner Riehl is not agreeable to the extension, the plan will be rejected automatically by January 28, 2016, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

**New Business:**

were received), second by Deb Libby, all in favor. All bidders will be contacted and advised that this item will be re-advertised in the local paper with bids due by February 8, 2016 and the decision made by March 14, 2016.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to reappoint Kaye Thoma as the delegate to the Dauphin County Tax Collection Committee (DCTCC), second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

Borough officials compensation was reviewed and Timothy Weaver made a motion to retain compensation at current rate, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

A motion to pay the borough bills that were read was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Jonathan Campbell, all in favor.

A motion to adjourn was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Jonathan Campbell, all in favor.
