

Minutes
Berrysburg Borough Council
July 8, 2013

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Marlin Troutman, Crystal Scheib, Deb Libby, Timothy Weaver, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice President - Scott Harner, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Also present were Lahn Kopp, Luke Scheib, Charles Bonawitz, Jonathan Campbell, Andy Welker, Rose Snyder, Esther Bordner, Cathi Kimmel, Julie Pucita, Nancy Kimmel, and Janet Bechtel.

Minutes for the June meeting were approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

Treasurer Report for June was approved with a motion by Scott Harner, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Public Comments – Rose Snyder questioned when the voting on Ordinance #27 was to be done. Council president responded the voting would take place during the new business of the meeting.

Old Business:

Jonathan Campbell discussed his storm water management plan and has requested an extension of 90 days to provide the finalized plan. Marlin Troutman made a motion to accept the 90 day extension request, second by Crystal Scheib, all in favor. Robin Snyder stated that a finalized plan must be received in 90 days.

Two bids were received for the 2013 road project.

New Business:

Scott Harner made a motion to amend Ordinance #27 to allow mowing on Sundays after 12 noon, second by Marlin Troutman. Voting on the motion was as follows: voting

yea were Scott, Robin, and Marlin; nays were Deb and Timothy, with Crystal abstaining from voting. The motion to amend the ordinance carried. The amendment to the ordinance will now be written and sent to the mayor to approve and back to council to be voted on at the next meeting.

COG report included the City of Harrisburg debt, electronic recycling, and infrastructure loans.

An intergovernmental agreement for the EMC for Mifflin Township, Berrysburg Borough, and Pillow Borough was received. Deb Libby made a motion to accept the agreement, second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

Janet Bechtel questioned council regarding her neighbor's property and whether anyone had contacted the bank to mow the grass. Property was listed as belonging to Bank of America but is now with another bank.

The mayor reported Deb Libby installed the mini blind at the borough building. The mayor has received a complaint regarding Stewart Witmer using his outdoor burner out of season.

Jonathan Campbell submitted a subdivision plan of his father's property. Crystal Scheib made a motion to send the plan to Cole Boyer (borough engineer) for review, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

A motion to pay borough bills was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

A motion to adjourn was made by Crystal Scheib, second by Timothy Weaver, all in favor.
