

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**July 14, 2014**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Deb Libby, Jody Boyer, Lahn Kopp, Crystal Scheib, Marlin Troutman, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice President – Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Also present was Jonathan Campbell.

Minutes for the June meeting were approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

Treasurer Report for June was approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Public Comments – None.

**Old Business:**

Robin Snyder contacted Cole Boyer, borough engineer, regarding grants for the Community Center. Cole advised that the best option for grants would be with the Gaming Commission. They will meet to work on the pre-application.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to accept Resolution 2014-03 regarding the road sign maintenance plan as written, second by Marlin Troutman, all in favor.

Jody Boyer made a motion to accept the purchase of the radios for the fire company and fire police from the Emergency Management Agency in the amount of \$1.00, second by Deb Libby, all in favor. Robin Snyder reported that Bob Savidge stated that all radios are accounted for that are on the bill of sale from the county.

**New Business:**

Jonathan Campbell presented council with a letter requesting permission to discharge next to the existing pipe that crosses underneath Pine Street since as part of his storm water management plan he is improving the shoulder of the road around the inlet for the pipe; and requested a waiver of the Financial Guarantee. Jonathan discussed the items listed in a letter from Alpha of January 6, 2014 regarding his storm water management plan. Robin Snyder requested a letter from Jonathan stating that council will hold the bill from Campbell Crops until his storm water management plan is completed for the Financial Guarantee. Timothy Weaver requested a copy of his latest storm water

management plan; Jonathan stated that he will have the plan by July 24<sup>th</sup>. Jonathan's engineer sent the Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan to the county.

Jody Boyer questioned repairing potholes in the borough. The road committee will gather a list of the potholes for the August meeting.

A motion to pay borough bills was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

A motion to adjourn was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Jody Boyer, all in favor.
