

Minutes
Berrysburg Borough Council
June 11, 2012

New Business:

Road Project – The borough engineer supplied council members with a street maintenance program and discussed paving projects for the borough. Scott Harner made a motion to proceed with Scenario 1 which includes portions of the following:

Walnut Street and SR 225, North 2nd Street, North 1st Street, and Cowden Street, second by Timothy Weaver, all in favor.

Jonathan Campbell discussed his storm water management plan and will have additional information by the July meeting.

Scott Harner made a motion to sign an agreement with JP Harris to collect the borough's delinquent taxes, second by Jody Boyer, all in favor.

A motion was made by Scott Harner, second by Marlin Troutman to pay the borough bills, all in favor.
