

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**June 10, 2013**

The mayor discussed mowing at the concrete plant on Mill Road. The mayor stated "If not cultivated must be mowed". The mayor also discussed the grant money that is available to upgrade the electric lighting in the Community Center.

An audit was performed by the Auditor General's office on the state monies for 2011 and 2012. A finding was discovered regarding a conflict of interest which was discussed. A formal report will be received shortly.

Travis Gladitsch (borough EMC) has requested an emergency management agreement be set up between Pillow Borough, Berrysburg Borough, and Mifflin Township.
