

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**June 13, 2016**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Jonathan Campbell, Lahn Kopp, Deb Libby, Crystal Scheib, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice President – Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Minutes for the May meeting were approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor.

Treasurer Report for May was approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Public Comments – none.

Mayor's report included the following: Martha Ryan is interested in buying the borough right of way between Lykens Street and the firehouse (Robin will discuss with the solicitor), Rod Collins of Collins Paving will meet with the Road Committee on Friday regarding road work (Mike will show him what needs done), and Vinny cleaned up his property.

**Old Business:**

Jonathan Campbell storm water management plan update – Jonathan reported that the drainage is working well without a pipe (the storm water must drain in 72 hours), and his engineer has filed for a new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit from DEP. Jonathan is laying top soil now and would like to sow grass seed.

Abner Riehl storm water management plan update – waiting on state paperwork.

Berrysburg Dollar General land development plan – received Operations and Maintenance Agreement (O & M) to be signed and returned to Cole Boyer, borough engineer. The building permit has been issued, and the financial security (bond) has been received.

Land development ordinance – being worked on and should have for next meeting.

Upper Dauphin Income Tax Office (UDITO) – the borough solicitor has been advised of the borough's recommendation regarding settlement.

**New Business:**

COG Meeting – no report. The June meeting will be held at Jefferson Township which includes a dinner before the meeting.

The Community Center would like to install the old borough post and sign where the old flag pole was located at the Community Center. The mayor has the name of a company that restores old signs and encourages boroughs to install the old signs. He will supply borough council with their information. The Community Center regular meeting will be held tomorrow night, June 14, 2016.
