

**Minutes**  
**Berrysburg Borough Council**  
**November 9, 2015**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance with the following members present – Jody Boyer, Lahn Kopp, Deb Libby, Crystal Scheib, Mayor - Michael Ward, President – Robin Snyder, Vice-President – Timothy Weaver, and Secretary/Treasurer - Diane Kennedy.

Also present were Cole Boyer, Michael & Alicia Bettis, Chris Shabals, Jonathan Campbell, and Marlin Warner.

Minutes for the October meeting were approved with a motion by Timothy Weaver, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Treasurer Report for October was approved with a motion by Jody Boyer, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Correspondence received was read.

Robin Snyder also received a letter from PA State Representative Mike Tobash regarding environmental education grants and a thank you note from Marlin Troutman.

Public Comments – none.

Mayor's report – Contacted Collins to patch potholes when he returns from Florida; Randy Shutt will replace the electric service on the damaged pole on the square; Gail Seiler plans to decorate for Christmas on November 21, 2015; Bixlers will shovel snow at the square again this year; and received an estimate from Wood Wise Tree Service to remove the tree at South 1<sup>st</sup> and Main Streets.

**Old Business:**

Timothy Weaver made a motion to advertise the 2016 proposed budget, second by Crystal Scheib, all in favor. The proposed budget will be placed on the borough web page and also posted on the borough bulletin board.

Timothy Weaver made a motion to approve Jonathan Campbell's proposed storm water management plan based on the recommendation of the borough engineer, Cole Boyer, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor except Jody Boyer who abstained. Cole Boyer sent an email to Jonathan Campbell on October 30, 2015 with items that need addressed regarding the proposed storm water management plan.

**New Business:**

COG Meeting – No report.

Michael Bettis presented to council a storm water management plan for his property at Mill and South 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets. Timothy Weaver made a motion to accept the storm water management plan for review by the borough engineer, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor except for Jody Boyer who abstained. The borough engineer discussed his concern with the location of the driveway with the Bettis' contractor, Chris Shabals. Timothy Weaver made a motion to proceed with the house construction and building permit, second by Deb Libby, all in favor except for Jody Boyer who abstained.

Jody Boyer made a motion to accept the Bixlers' offer to shovel snow at the square again this year, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.

Crystal Scheib made a motion to accept the estimate from Wood Wise Tree Service to cut the maple tree and grind the stump at South 1<sup>st</sup> and Main Streets for \$525, second by Timothy Weaver, all in favor. Timothy Weaver will dispose of the wood.

A motion to pay the borough bills that were read was made by Timothy Weaver, second by Lahn Kopp, all in favor except for Jody Boyer who abstained.

A motion to adjourn was made by Jody Boyer, second by Deb Libby, all in favor.
