The borough tax collector has requested the compensation currently paid be reviewed by council (current amount paid is 5% of amounts collected).

Timothy Weaver made a motion to accept an agreement with Keystone Collections to process the 2011 unprocessed returns according to a letter received from the borough attorney, second by Scott Harner, all in favor.

A motion was made by Scott Harner, second by Timothy Weaver to pay the borough bills, all in favor.
