ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS SPRING STREET, AND A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS COWDEN STREET, AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH THEREOF.

THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following street, which is hereby designated as Spring Street, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg: Beginning at the intersection of Heller Street and Eighth Street. Extended and proceeding eastwardly 225 feet, at a width of 14 feet, to Cowden Street, and thence eastwardly, at a width of 14 feet, 575 feet, pursuant to Plan of Lots laid out by John Romberger.

SECTION 2. The following street, which is hereby designated as Cowden Street, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg: Beginning at the intersection of Spring Street and proceeding northwardly, at a width of 16 feet, 90 feet to the intersection at Route No. 225.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance, or parts of any Ordinance, inconsistent herewith, is hereby repealed.
