ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS PUBLIC STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, STREETS TO BE DESIGNATED AS LYKENS STREET, HELLER STREET, SOUTH SECOND STREET, SOUTH FIRST STREET, NORTH FIRST STREET, AND NORTH SECOND STREET.

THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a certain alley in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called West Alley, Seminary Street, or Lykens Alley, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as Lykens Street: Beginning at South Second Street (formerly known as South Alley), and continuing in a general northerly direction to the Borough of Berrysburg line, a total length of two thousand eight hundred thirteen (2,813) feet and total width of twenty (20) feet.

SECTION 2. That a certain alley in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called Heller's Alley, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as Heller Street: Beginning at South Second Street (formerly known as South Alley), and continuing in a general northerly direction to North Second Street (formerly known as High Street), a total length of one thousand one hundred twenty-five (1,125) feet and total width of twenty (20) feet.

SECTION 3. That a certain alley in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called South Alley, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as South Second Street: Beginning at Lykens Street on the west and continuing in a general eastwardly direction to Mill Road, a total length of two thousand six hundred twenty-five (2,625) feet and total width of twenty (20) feet.

SECTION 4. That certain alleys and streets in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called Fifth Alley, Sixth Alley, Seventh Alley, Eighth Alley, Spring Street and Strawberry Street, be and the same are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as one public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as South First Street: Beginning at Lykens Street on the west and continuing in a general eastwardly direction to Old Midland Railroad right-of-way, a total length of two thousand three hundred sixty-two (2,362) feet and total width of twenty (20) feet.

SECTION 5. That certain alleys in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called First Alley, Second Alley, Third Alley and Fourth Alley, be and the same are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as one public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as North First Street: Beginning on the west at Lykens Street and continuing in a general eastwardly direction to Heller Street, a total length of one thousand five hundred sixty (1,560) feet and total width of twenty (20) feet.

SECTION 6. That a certain street in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called High Street, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg, which is hereby designated as North Second Street: Beginning at Lykens Street on the west and continuing in a general eastwardly direction to Heller Street, a total length of one thousand five hundred sixty (1,560) feet and total width of thirty-four (34) feet.
