### ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS PUBLIC STREETS IN THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, NORTH FIRST STREET AND COWDEN STREET.

THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a certain street in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called North First Street, beginning at Heller Street and continuing in a general easterly direction to Cowden Street, a total length of three hundred forty (340) feet and total width of thirty-three (33) feet, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg.

SECTION 2. That a certain street in the Borough of Berrysburg commonly known as and called Cowden Street, beginning at Market Street and continuing in a general northerly direction to North First Street, a total length of two hundred thirty-one (231) feet and total width of forty (40) feet, be and the same is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Berrysburg.
