ORDINANCE NO. 21

PERTAINING TO DISORDERLY PRACTICE. DEFINING DISORDERLY PRACTICE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BURGESS AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME THAT DISORDERLY PRACTICE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG SHALL BE AND IS HEREBY DEFINED AS AN ACT, WORD, OR PRACTICE CAUSING OR TENDING TO CAUSE A DISTURBANCE OF THE PEACE AND GOOD ORDER OF THE BOROUGH, OR TENDING TO CAUSE ANY DISCOMFORT OR ANOYANCE TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE BOROUGH OR USERS OF THE BOROUGH THOROFARES, AND SHALL INCLUDE LOAFING, FIGHTING, DRUNKENNESS, VAGRANCY, BEGGING, THE MAKING OF UNNESSARY NOISES, PROFANITY OR INDECENT LANGUAGE. ALL THE FOREGOING OFFENSES AS COMING WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF SAID DISORDERLY PRACTICE ARE HEREBY DECLARED TO BE UNLAWFUL.

ANY PERSON OR PERSONS VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE, OR CAUSING, OR HELPING OTHERS TO VIOLATE IT, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF FIVE (5) TO FIFTY (50) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENCE, AND IN DEFAULT OF PAYING SAID FINE SHALL BE COMMITTED TO THE COUNTY LOCK-UP FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING FIVE (5) DAYS.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

ENACTED and ORDAINED this 6th day of April, A.D., 1970 by the Borough Council lawfully assembled.
