ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, THE COUNCIL FOR BERRYSBURG BOROUGH, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DEEMS IT ADVISABLE FOR REASONS OF PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE, THAT THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES WITHIN THE BOROUGH LIMITS BE REGULATED.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, AND IT IS ENACTED AND ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THIS BOROUGH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. For purposes of this Ordinance a "snowmobile" means any engine driven vehicle of a type which utilizes sled-type runners, or skis, or an endless belt tread or any combination of these or other similar means of contact with the surface upon which it is operated, but does not include any farm tractor, highway or other construction equipment, or any military or law enforcement vehicle.

SECTION 2. No such snowmobile, defined in Section 1 above, shall be operated within the Borough limits of the Borough of Berrysburg between the hours of 10 P.M. and 7 A.M.

SECTION 3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.
