ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITATIONS ON SPECIFIED BOROUGH STREETS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ENACTS AND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. This ordinance is passed for the protection of the health, safety, morals, general welfare and property of the inhabitants of the Borough of Berrysburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. No person shall park a vehicle, or allow the same to remain parked no longer than 15 minutes at the following locations:

- (a) On the south side of East and West Park Avenue;
- (b) On the East side of Walnut Street.

SECTION 3. Appropriate signs shall be erected giving notice of these parking restrictions.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for the first 15 minutes of overtime parking and Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each additional 15 minutes, and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 5 days. Provided: It shall be the duty of the Mayor, or the President or Vice President of Council when acting as Mayor pursuant to the Borough Code, to report to the Borough Secretary violations of this Ordinance indicating, in each case, the violation, the license number of the vehicle involved in such violation, the location where such violation took place and the time of such violation. The Mayor or acting Mayor making such report shall also attach to every such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this Ordinance, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that if he shall report to the Office of the Borough Secretary and pay, for the use of the Borough, the sum of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) relevant to the first 15 minutes violation and Four Dollars (\$4.00) for each additional 15 minutes of overtime parking, within 48 hours after the time of such notice, within such time limit, the same shall save such violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs herein above prescribed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the erection of appropriate signs pursuant to Section 2 above.

SECTION 6. In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance, it being the intent of this borough that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions which are inconsistent with this ordinance shall be, and the same expressly are repealed.
