ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPENING OF MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF BERRYSBURG, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA. FROM LINE OF PROPERTY OF MRS. DANIEL LOWER AND JACOB HOAK TO THE NORTHERN LINE OF THE BOROUGH AND FIXING THE WIDTH THEREOF.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Berrysburg and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same. That Main Street be opened the full width of fifty feet between the properties of Mrs. Daniel Lower and Jacob Hoak and the northern boundary line of the Borough. The center line thereof to follow the center line of the concrete highway to the northern line of the Borough.

SECTION 2. The width of said street shall be fifty feet from curb to curb.

SECTION 3. The Highway Committee is authorized and instructed, as soon as this ordinance shall go into effect, to meet, or communicate with the property owners along said street and endeavor to agree with them, subject to the Approval of the Town Council upon the compensation for damages, or the benefits if any, accruing from the opening of said street and in case such agreement can not be effected or if not approved by the Council. The President and Secretary of the Town Council are directed without delay to apply to the proper Court for the appointment of Viewers to assess damages and benefits as may be incurred and acquired according to law.

Ordained and enacted into law this 2nd day of March 1926.
