---

**Prohibiting the Driving and Parking of Vehicles, Trailers and other Unauthorized Equipment and the Dumping of Materials or Refuse on the Grass or Unpaved Areas of the Borough Square.**

**Whereas** the unauthorized driving and parking of vehicles, trailers, or other unauthorized equipment and the unauthorized dumping of materials and refuse has damaged the grass and unpaved areas of the "Borough Square", which is property owned by the Borough of Berrysburg in and around the center of the Borough of Berrysburg sometimes referred to as the "Borough Commons" with said boundaries being defined by a properly recorded deed and as drawn on the official Berrysburg Borough Square Survey Map and Plans for the Commons for the Borough of Berrysburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania; as surveyed and drawn for the borough by William A. Burch and Associates of Millersburg, Pennsylvania and dated April 17, 1986;  
**now**


**Therefore be it resolved** by the Berrysburg Borough Council that driving, parking of vehicles, trailers or other unauthorized equipment or the unauthorized dumping or placing of materials or refuse shall not be allowed on the grass or unpaved areas of the heretofore mentioned "Borough Square" except as permitted by written lease agreement or special written permission granted by the Berrysburg Borough Council. This resolution **shall not** apply to official emergency vehicles, utility vehicles, authorized snow removal equipment, grass mowing equipment or other vehicles specifically required or permitted by Berrysburg Borough Council Ordinance or Berrysburg Borough Council Resolution or an authorized representative of the Berrysburg Borough Council;

**Therefore be it resolved** by the Berrysburg Borough Council effective immediately upon the adoption of this resolution; any person who shall violate this resolution shall be cited by a properly authorized borough representative and have their vehicle(s), trailers or other unauthorized equipment, materials or refuse; immediately towed or removed and impounded at the owner's expense. Upon conviction, any person who shall violate this resolution shall be sentenced to pay a fine of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, plus towing and impound costs, the costs of prosecution, and the costs for restoration of all incurred damage to borough property or landscaping resulting from such violation. 

responsible for violation of this resolution shall be given a reasonable period of time to pay all costs and fines due the borough, as determined by the District Justice or the Court of proper jurisdiction. In default of payment of any or all of the aforementioned costs and penalties, a municipal lien shall be filed against the responsible person's property and the property shall be sold at public auction by the Dauphin County Sheriff.
